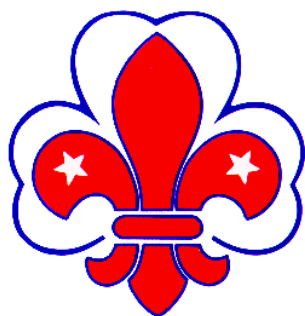
The guild has reduced slightly with 83 members last year and **79** members as at September 2013.

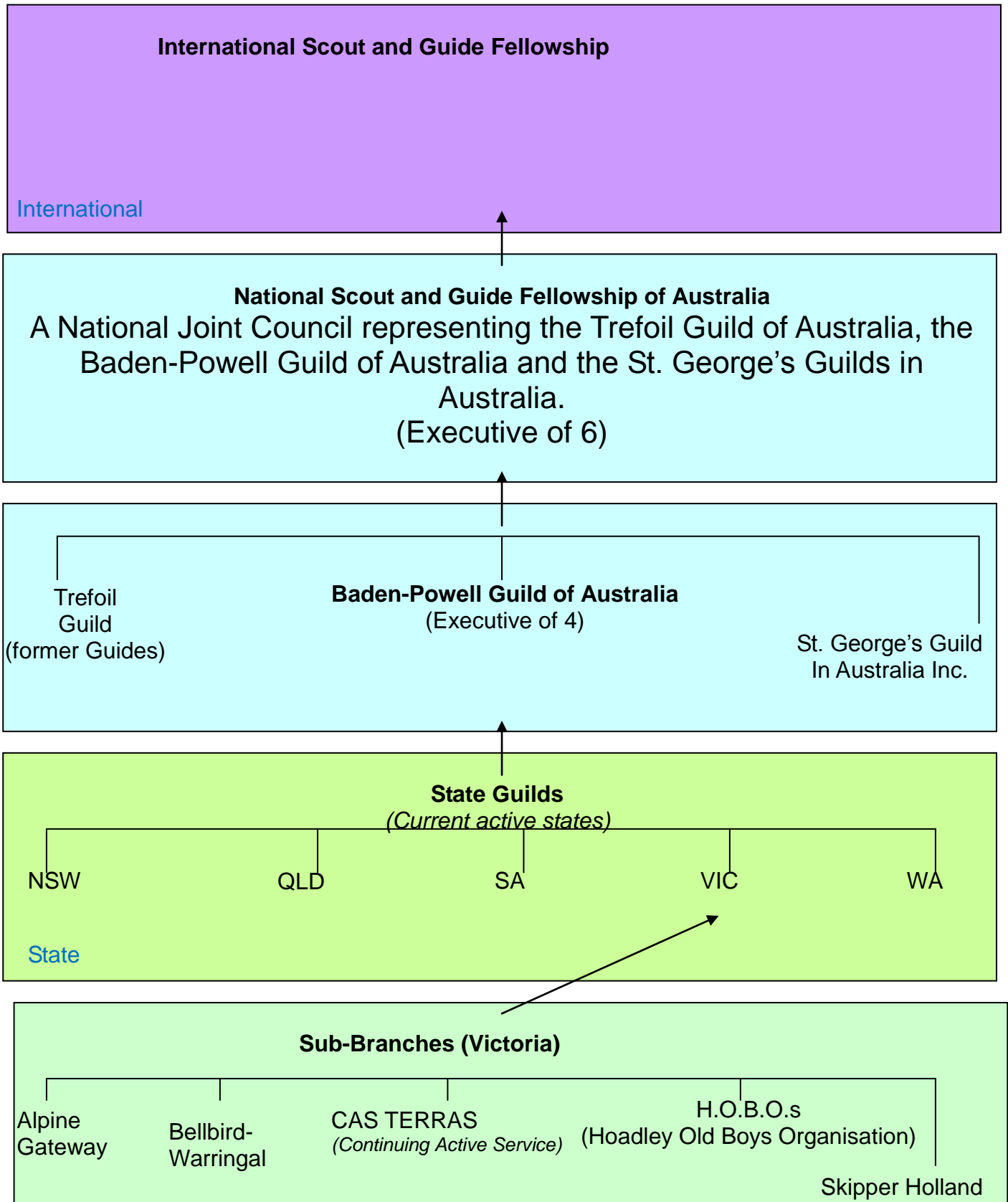
