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With less than 12 months to go for the start of the 27th ISGF-AISG World Conference the Registration Forms, the Volunteer Form and Day Participant Form are now available. In Australia these forms are to be dealt with as follows:

- State Trefoil Guild Advisers and Baden Powell Guildmasters are asked to notify members that they hold copies of these forms and issue to members as requested. (Note: it is expected that the Conference Participant form will also be available for download from the ISGF website).
- Members to complete the form appropriate to their attendance.
 - “Conference Participant” joins all aspects of the Conference (see program, choice of excursions and choice of accommodation). *Closing date 30 April 2014*
 - “Conference Accompanying Member” for anyone wanting to come to Sydney but not attend the Conference. They may visit friends during the day or sightsee but wish to stay with a member at their hotel, enjoy an evening meal at the Conference, and go on any of the day trips or the Dinner Cruise. An “Accompanying” attendee needs to enclose a copy of the remittance sent by the Conference Participant with whom they plan to partner. *Closing date 30 April 2014.*
 - “Day Participant” This entitles a participant entrance to conference, morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea on 1 day only. *Payment and form must be received by 30 June 2014*
 - “Volunteer Form” - those who offer to assist for a specified number of hours as a volunteer. *Payment and form must be received by 30 June 2014.*
- Forms to be completed and forwarded, with payment, as instructed. It is important that all the information should be clear and if possible typed, as this registration form allows it to be typed in, saved and printed out or if written must be very clear so that no mistakes are made with the information presented. *Note closing dates.*
- At their 4 May 2014 meeting, NSGFA Executive will nominate Australia’s Delegates. Each country is entitled to 4 Delegates and the Australian members chosen will be 2 from BPG and 2 from TG.

Most things are in place and the committee is working hard to ensure that all things go as planned and with your help that this can be achieved so please do not hesitate to volunteer as it is a great opportunity for all to meet overseas members and make new friendships.

We ask all members to try and book flights arriving in Sydney on the morning of Friday the 10th October as it makes transport to the site easier in the morning than in the afternoon. The Sydney traffic in afternoon peak hour can be very heavy exiting from the airport.

Further information will be forthcoming when we get closer to the conference and the committee is getting excited about seeing everyone in Sydney in 12 months.
